Frequently Asked Questions – Audio & Sound Equipment

AV SYSTEM

Q: What is included with the complimentary PA system?

A: Included with the complimentary PA system is a DVD player, CD player, four microphones and a PA system. Please contact our Event Sales Office for a detailed list of the PA system components if required.

Q: How many sets of projectors and screens are provided for the event?

A: We can provide a maximum of two projectors and screens of size 7 feet x 7 feet for your event on a complementary basis.

Q: What is the model of the projector?

A: The model is 3M-X56

Brightness (ANSI Lumens) : 5000 Lumens

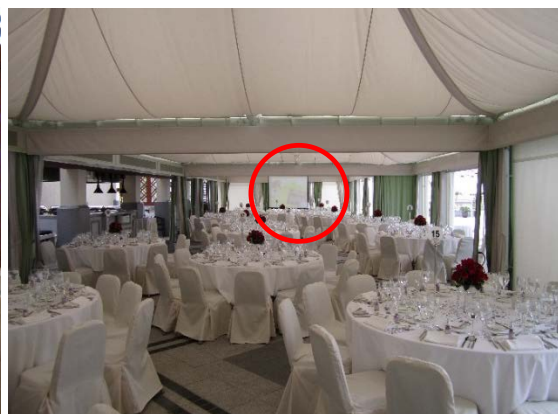
Resolution (Native / Max) : XGA (1024 x 768) / XGA (1600 x 1200)

Q: Where are the projectors and screens set up at the venues?

A: Please refer to the attached floor plan for the location of the projectors and screens for your reference only. These are represented by the red circles.

Q: Can I rent more projectors and screens for my event and, if so, at what charge?

A: You may rent maximum one more set of projector and screen at a charge of HK\$1,500 net.

Q: Can I use the projector and screen at lunch time?

A: Yes, you may use the projector and screen during lunch. However, please note that the projection will not be as clear as during dinner time, because the reflection of the sunlight may affect the image.

MUSIC

Q: Apart from iPod and CD, can our other MP3 files be played?

A: Your MP3 files may be played through the DVD player.

Q: For CD music, which format should we use?

A: The CD player can play CD, CD-R / CD-RW. The content should be recorded in CD audio format. The CD changer accepts only three inch compact discs with CD-audio only. We recommend that you schedule a test run of yourself made CD in our system a few days before the event, this is subject to restaurant's availability.

Q: Can the band use your PA system for their musical instruments?

A: No musical instruments or equipment can be plugged into our PA system.

Q: Can we bring our own PA system for our event?

A: Self arranged PA systems are not allowed on The Front Lawn and Seaview Terrace. Self arranged PA systems are allowed at The Marquee and The Verandah. Please also note that the Management reserves the right to request that you lower the volume of music or amplified sound if it is deemed excessive.
